- Dr. Marc Ecker served as superintendent of the Fountain Valley School District from 1996 until his retirement in December 2014, serving a total of 18 ½ years in the position. He served as Chair of the Orange County Special Education Alliance and is a two term past president of the Orange County Superintendent's Organization, 2006-08.
- Dr. Ecker is a past president of the Association of California School Administrators (ACSA) and serves as a consultant at ACSA Academies for principals, chief business officials and superintendents, speaking on school finance and school board effectiveness.
- Dr. Ecker served with other leading superintendents in providing input and advice on the development of the Local Control Funding Formula to the Governor and his staff.
- Dr. Ecker has served on the State Public Schools Accountability Act Advisory Committee and two terms on the Financial Crisis Management Assistance Team Advisory Board. He continues to serve as a member of the board for the California League of Schools and served as president of the Association of Middle Level Education.
- Dr. Ecker received the Tracey Gaffey Mentorship Award from ACSA Region XVII in 2008, was recognized as the Orange County Superintendent of the Year in 2009 and was awarded the Lifetime Service Award in 2015 by the Association of California School Administrators
- Dr. Ecker currently serves as Chair of the Board of Directors for Schools First Federal Credit Union, the largest credit union in California and the fifth largest nationally with assets over \$11 billion.
- Dr. Ecker serves as the Distinguished Lecturer in the College of Education, California State University, Fullerton teaching graduate level courses in Educational Leadership
- Dr. Ecker is an active member of Rotary and served as past president of the Fountain Valley Rotary Club.
