The successful candidate will possess the highest level of communication skills and integrity, a collaborative style, high energy and be focused on improving achievement for all students as well as embrace the importance of equity and partnerships with community and staff. The superintendent, as chief executive officer of the district, provides the overall leadership for curriculum and instruction, standards and assessment, finance, budgeting, personnel, and school facilities and develops effective communication, collaboration, and outreach with the community, parents and staff.

Finalists will have an opportunity to familiarize themselves with the community and schools. Board members reserve the right to visit the district and communities of a candidate prior to a final decision. The superintendent will be expected to begin as soon as possible upon mutual agreement between the selected candidate and the Board.

The salary will be competitive and based upon qualifications and experience. A multi-year contract will be considered.

The city of Riverside is a city in Riverside County, California, located in the Inland Empire metropolitan area. Riverside is the county seat of the eponymous county and named for its location beside the Santa Ana River. It is the most populous city in the Inland Empire and in Riverside County, and is located about 60 miles (97 km) east of Los Angeles. It is also part of the Greater Los Angeles area. Riverside was founded in the early 1870s. It is the birthplace of the California citrus industry and home of the Mission Inn, the largest Mission Revival Style building in the United States. It is also home to the Riverside National Cemetery. The University of California, Riverside, is located in the northeastern part of the city. Other attractions in Riverside include the Fox Performing Arts Center, Riverside Metropolitan Museum, which houses exhibits and artifacts of local history, the California Museum of Photography, the California Citrus State Historic Park, and the Parent Washington Navel Orange Tree, the last of the two original navel orange trees in California.
