- Has strong leadership and communication skills
- Is able to allocate funds based on student data and equity

- A strong fiscal background and understanding of the budget
- A record of focusing on students and improving achievement in a diverse community
- Experience as a teacher, principal and as a central office administrator

SELECTION PROCESS

THE DISTRICT

The Banta Elementary School District serves more than 770 students from Grades K-8. Banta Elementary School District is composed of a diverse group of students. Our mission statement is one that all staff members take to heart each and every day: "With integrity and compassion, Banta Elementary School District promotes a commitment to excellence, while empowering each individual to strive for the character, knowledge and skills necessary to make a positive difference in our world." Our student population is 37% English learner (EL) and 72.29% are classified as Low Income, our LCFF Unduplicated count is 74.44%. Our student population is made up of several ethnicities with the majority of our students 46.36% identifying as Hispanic Latino, 25.21% White, .55% Asian and 1.11% African American. We serve approximately 365 students Transitional Kindergarten through 8th grade at one quality school. The district also authorizes one charter school.

THE COMMUNITY

Banta is a small unincorporated community in San Joaquin County, California. Historically, it was a major interchange point between the Central Pacific and Southern Pacific railroads. It was located on the route of the transcontinental railroad from Sacramento to the San Francisco Bay Area by way of the Altamont Pass and Niles Canyon before the Central Pacific bought the route of the California Pacific which ran north of the Carquinez Strait to Vallejo. Central Pacific diverted the California Pacific line to Benicia, California and established a railroad ferry between Benicia and Port Costa across the Carquinez Strait.
