THE DISTRICT

The Mariposa County Unified School District is a small, rural county located to the east of the San Joaquin Valley in central California. Mariposa is one of seven single-district counties in California, whereby the organization functions as both county office of education and district office.

The Superintendent serves both the District and the County. The position of County Superintendent is an elected one and therefore requires the Superintendent to stand for re-election every four years.

Mariposa is a one-district county with eight school sites and a total student population of approximately 1,700 students. Home to Yosemite National Park, the county consists of small, rural communities in the Sierra Nevada foothills; an area rich in Gold Rush history and great natural beauty.

THE COMMUNITY

Mariposa is located in the western foothills of the Sierra Nevada, at the doorstep of Yosemite National Park and the Sierra National Forest. The county of 18,000 residents is located 2:45 minutes from San Francisco, 90 minutes from Fresno, and 2:30 minutes from Monterey.

Mariposa offers a historically rich community. When California was formed in 1850, Mariposa County was one of the original 27 counties and covered one-fifth of the state. The County was reapportioned to create all of parts of 11 other counties giving rise to the nickname the "Mother of Counties."

With no incorporated cities (or stop lights), people either live in rural areas or in one of our many charming communities. They also enjoy varied outdoor recreational opportunities as the terrain ranges from grassy rolling hills to alpine-like mountains. With Yosemite National Park just minutes away, the Yosemite Wilderness has over 750 miles of trail to explore, is home to countless waterfalls, world class rock climbing, giant sequoias, backpacking, biking, fishing, horseback riding, camping, and winter sports.

Today, Mariposa is an active community that has numerous festivals and celebrations throughout the year. Higher education opportunities are available at UC Merced and Merced Community College. Mariposa is known for friendly citizens who greet or play host to the large number of visitors who come from around the world each year. Finally, Mariposa is known for its fun spirit which is enjoyed by visitors and locals, alike.
