The Oxnard School District seeks a superintendent who:

- Understands each of the divisions and departments of a district, knows how to delegate and empower, and knows how to bring staff together to work as a cohesive team
- Has extensive knowledge of and support for Dual Immersion
- Has experience in contract negotiations and has trusting relationships with teachers, support staff, classified staff, and unions
- Has experience in oversight of school, district finances, budgets, business management and school facilities/district bonds
- Is committed to being highly visible and regularly engages with staff throughout the district and with parents and community members
- Is an effective communicator and is inclusive in regularly seeking input from staff and other stakeholders in the community to ensure that there is not a disconnect of involvement
- Has experience in working well with community partners including the City of Oxnard and the Faith community

The consultants will review applications and recommend candidates to the board for interviews and further consideration. The Board members will receive all applications. Board members reserve the right to visit the district and communities of a candidate prior to a final decision.
