The San Rafael City Schools seeks a superintendent who:

- Is a well-respected leader in the district they now serve
- Has good relations with the employee associations
- Is action oriented and a problem solver
- Ensures the success of English Language Learners
- Has a good understanding of the district budget and state finances
- Understands the importance of technology in learning
- Will involve stakeholders in decision-making
- Will balance and value all aspects of the organization

Finalists will have an opportunity to familiarize themselves with the community and schools. Board members reserve the right to visit the district and communities of a candidate prior to a final decision.

The salary will be competitive and based upon qualifications and experience. A multi-year contract will be considered.

THE DISTRICT

The San Rafael City Schools community ensures that every student receives an empowering education. High expectations and skillful individualized instruction enable each student to embrace their own learning, think critically and experience success.

Our welcoming school climate ensures that our diverse community of students, families, staff and community members are treated with dignity and respect, creating opportunities for participation, engagement and support. Every student graduates college and/or career ready, able to take responsibility for a future that includes life-long learning.

SRCS includes the San Rafael Elementary School District and the San Rafael High School District, with a combined student population of more than 7,200. The two districts are governed by one school board and one district office administration. The Elementary School District is composed of nine schools. The High School District provides secondary education to students residing in two elementary districts: Dixie School District and

San Rafael Elementary School District. The High School District has two comprehensive 9-12 high schools and a continuation high school.

In accordance with the City Charter, the San Rafael City Schools represents two separate school districts: one for elementary grades (K-8) and one for the high school level (9-12).

THE COMMUNITY

San Rafael is the oldest, largest and most culturally diverse city in Marin and also enjoys the best weather. San Rafael is a lively business and cultural center located in an area of incomparable natural beauty.

At the city's heart is its charming, vibrant downtown shopping district with a mixture of Victorian buildings, ethnic restaurants, retail stores and financial institutions. In July 2017, the California Arts Council selected San Rafael as one of California's premier state-designated arts and culture districts.

The San Rafael community enjoys seasonal events such as the Thursday night farmers markets and summertime concerts, and offers many sites to visit and activities such as the nearby authentic recreation of Mission San Rafael Arcangel; founded in 1817 as part of California's mission chain; many beautifully restored turn-of-the century buildings, including the Falkirk Cultural Center, and the 106-year-old Dominican University; and the Marin County Civic Center, home to the county's government offices and an architectural treasure, designed by architect Frank Lloyd Wright.

Parklands and open space account for nearly 30 percent of the city's land. Since it borders the San Pablo Bay, San Rafael has an abundance of marinas and many water-oriented recreational activities are available. Nature lovers will appreciate the quiet beauty of China Camp State Park, a 1,600-acre park with hiking and biking trails and overnight campsites.
