MDUSD is a K-12 district located in Contra Costa County, serving more than 31,000 students at one of more than 50 school sites in the cities of Clayton, Concord, Pleasant Hill; portions of Martinez, Pittsburg and Walnut Creek; and unincorporated communities of Bay Point, Lafayette, and Pacheco.
