The selected candidate will love the South Lake Tahoe lifestyle and a community in which seasonal tourism thrives. The Board is seeking an exceptional leader who will fit well into an active and engaged community. The selected leader will appreciate the District size, the dedicated, outstanding teachers, administrators, and support staff, the District's diverse demographics, and high expectations for students and their academic success. We are a District in which staff, students, and the community actively support our schools. If you are seeking a long-term relationship with a District of 3,900 students, in a community with multiple recreational activities and incredible opportunities to make a difference with our students, you are encouraged to apply for the position.

DESIRED EDUCATION/EXPERIENCE (PREFERRED)

- Has been a successful leader, preferably a superintendent or an assistant/associate superintendent, in one or more California school districts
- Has a Masters degree or higher with a record of continuous learning (Doctorate preferable)
- Has a solid record as an educator, with K-12 experience in California
- Has had experience as a teacher, principal and as a central office administrator
- Has successful experience working with budgets and district finance, including LCFF and LCAP, increased special education costs and implications of STRS/PERS liabilities
- Bilingual candidates are invited to apply

SELECTION PROCESS

The Board of Education has retained Consultants Rich Fischer and Rich Thome of Leadership Associates to recruit qualified candidates. The consultants will screen applications and recommend candidates to the Board for interviews and further consideration. Any contact with board members, in an attempt to influence the selection process, will be considered a breach of professional ethics. Finalists will have an opportunity to familiarize themselves with the community and schools. Board members reserve the right to visit the district and communities of a candidate prior to a final decision.

SALARY AND CONTRACT

The salary will be competitive and based upon qualifications and experience. A multi-year contract will be considered.

THE DISTRICT

The Lake Tahoe Unified School District serves approximately 3,900 students with one comprehensive, accredited high school, one middle school, four elementary schools, and one continuation high school. The student population is comprised of 48% White, 42% Hispanic, and 3% Filipino; 24% English Learners, 58% Free & Reduced, 12% Special Education, and 6% Homeless (of the total population). The students, staff, and families of Lake Tahoe Unified School District take great pride in their small town and relationships, working together to support low-income families, always striving for equity among students, and providing opportunities for families to feel a sense of connectedness with their schools.

THE COMMUNITY

The District is located in beautiful South Lake Tahoe, California, a resort community situated in the Sierra Nevada mountains, next to the Nevada state line, at 6,300 feet elevation. The small population of 22,000 year-round residents grows to over 100,000 during two distinct tourist seasons--winter and summer. South Lake Tahoe is world renowned for its location on the banks of beautiful Lake Tahoe, its ski resorts, beaches, mountain peaks, and the Stateline area where entertainment and nightlife can be found. The business economy is based mainly on tourism – ski, recreation and casino/hotel industries.
