The Le Grand Union High School District seeks a superintendent who:

- Has proven skills as an analytical, data-based decision maker
- Knows the breadth and depth of the role of superintendent in a small school district
- Is experienced in a variety of areas including human resources, school finance, curriculum and instruction, facilities and facilities maintenance
- Evidences history of high expectations for all; is consistent using policies, rules and regulations in dealing with staff, students and stakeholders
- Knows and has successful experience in and with like demographics of the communities
- Values a small, rural community based in agriculture; is family-oriented
- Knows Le Grand UHSD specifically, the test scores and programs in the district

SELECTION PROCESS

The Board of Education has retained Consultant Sally Frazier of Leadership Associates to recruit qualified candidates. The consultant will screen applications and recommend candidates to the Board for interviews and further consideration. The Board will have the opportunity to review all applications submitted. Any contact with board members, in an attempt to influence the selection process, will be considered a breach of professional ethics. Finalists will have an opportunity to familiarize themselves with the community and schools. Board members reserve the right to visit the District and communities of a candidate prior to a final decision.

The salary will be competitive and based upon qualifications and experience. This approximate salary range is \$170,000-190,000.

THE DISTRICT AND COMMUNITY

The Le Grand Union High School District (LGUHSD) is a high school district in Merced County serving a rural community in grades 9-12. The district has two schools. District enrollment is approximately 500 students.

The district maintains a co-ed athletic program with 4 boys' and 4 girls' teams and 3 co-ed teams. The district has medical and agricultural academies along with an extensive after school program that services more than 150 students. In 2017 Newsweek magazine listed LGHS as the 185th best high school in CA out of over 1,000 California high schools. US News & World Report gave LGHS the Silver award for outstanding high schools in California for the 2014-15, 2016-17, 2017-18, 2019-20, 2020-21 and 2021-22 school years.

According to US News, 41.8% of LGUHSD students are college ready and 64% of LGUHSD students who take an AP test pass it with a 3 or higher. The district serves three feeder districts.

The mission of LGUHSD is to promote college and career readiness through Communication, Collaboration, Critical thinking, Creativity, Citizenship, and Character. To achieve this mission, the district has chosen the following learner outcomes: that all students must possess and demonstrate the following skills upon completion of their learning experience: Communication, Collaboration, Critical thinking, Creativity, Citizenship, and Character.

The district's vision is to create a distinguished learning community that fosters socially responsible citizens determined to succeed.
