PROFESSIONAL PROFILE

The Tehachapi Unified School District seeks a superintendent who:

- Has experience as a teacher and administrator at various K-12 levels, including as a district level executive leader
- Has experience working with labor unions and maintaining a positive collaborative working relationship
- Has a strong background in fiscal management, budget development and facilities management
- Is a strong instructional leader and has a proven track record of increasing student achievement
- Is student centered and puts students first in decision making
- Has an equity minded approach
- Has special education expertise and knowledge of special education laws and best practices
- Is community centered and has the ability to connect with parents, community partners, and local organizations
- Has knowledge of protocols for school safety and places the highest priority on safe environments for students and staff
- Has the ability to navigate the politics of a small community
- Will use data to make decisions
- Has a willingness to stay in the district long term and maintain stability

Board members reserve the right to visit the District and communities of a candidate prior to a final decision.
