The Coalinga-Huron Unified School District seeks a superintendent who:

- Has experience as a teacher and administrator at various K-12 levels, including as a district level leader
- Has experience working with labor unions and maintaining a positive collaborative working relationship
- Has a strong background in fiscal management and budget development
- Is a strong and effective instructional leader and has a proven track record of increasing student achievement
- Is able to lead and inspire staff, students and communities
- Is community centered and has the ability to connect with parents, community partners, and labor organizations
- Has the ability to navigate the politics of two communities
- Will use data to make decisions
- Has a willingness to stay in the district long-term and maintain stability
- Ensures consistent and equitable application of district policies and procedures

SELECTION PROCESS

The Board of Education has retained Consultants Juan Garza and Sally Frazier, Ed.D., of Leadership Associates to recruit qualified candidates. The consultants will screen applications and recommend candidates to the Board for interviews and further consideration. The Board will have the opportunity to review all applications

submitted. Any contact with board members, in an attempt to influence the selection process, will be considered a breach of professional ethics. Finalists will have an opportunity to familiarize themselves with the community and schools. Board members reserve the right to visit the District and communities of a candidate prior to a final decision.

SALARY AND CONTRACT

The salary will be competitive and based upon qualifications and experience. This approximate salary range is \$220,000 - \$275,000.
