The Irvine Unified School District seeks a superintendent who:

- Has been an executive cabinet leader, superintendent experience desirable
- Has executive level experience working in a comparable school district
- Has a proven track record of adapting to changing circumstances and navigating complex issues
- Is culturally competent with a demonstrated record and commitment to equity and inclusion
- Possesses excellent communication skills, both written and verbal, and is open, consistent and transparent in all communications
- Has a proven track record of involving others in decision-making and being responsive to their input
- Has a solid understanding of K-12 budgets and state finances and is able to leverage and maximize both internal and external resources
- Has the ability to successfully build capacity in others
- Has successful experiences working collaboratively with labor groups
- Is comfortable leading with a philosophy of empowered autonomy for schools, with clear accountability

SELECTION PROCESS

The consultants will screen applications and recommend candidates to the Board for interviews and further consideration. The Board will have the opportunity to review all applications submitted. Any contact with board members, in an attempt to influence the selection process, will be considered a breach of professional ethics. Finalists will have an opportunity to familiarize themselves with the community and schools. Board members reserve the right to visit the District and communities of a candidate prior to a final decision.

SALARY AND CONTRACT

The salary will be competitive and based upon qualifications and experience. This approximate salary range is \$345,000-\$425,000.
